Dear Parents and Carers

We have had a great week in school this week, with everyone working hard and achieving lots. On Tuesday we welcomed a trainer from Read, Write, Inc (our phonics programme), who was delighted when watching our teachers and teaching assistants teaching reading in EYFS and KS1. She was hugely impressed with the level of teaching, as well as the engagement and progress from the children – well done to all involved.

On Wednesday, we had a visit from some local headteachers, teachers and SENDCos who came to see our SEND provision and how we meet the needs of all of our children. They praised what they saw, and left with many ideas to take back to implement in their own schools.

On Sunday 19th October, the Church will celebrate World Mission Sunday; this is the one Sunday in the year when the Mass is celebrated exclusively for missionary activity. World Mission Sunday is our chance to show love and solidarity to our brothers and sisters overseas. Donations are collected at these worldwide Masses and they go, in their entirety, to support churches, hospitals, schools and vocations in countries where the Church is new, young or poor.

We were delighted and so proud to hear about our Mission Team's visit to Dunstable last Friday. Adults who accompanied the children told us how well-behaved they all were, how beautifully they sang and responded to the Celebrant, and how well they represented our school. They were sat behind a number of ex-Holy Family pupils too, who are now in Year 7 and 8, and it was lovely to see the progression of our children, and a continuation of their faith.

Our reformed PTA will be hosting a couple of events between now and Christmas, and it would be fantastic to see as many parents as possible getting involved to help out and further build our school community. There will be a coffee morning on Wednesday 5th November, and a Christmas Fair after school on Friday 5th December – more details to follow.

Coming home with the children on Monday will be a postcard which explains Catholic Social Teaching and our school's virtues. We ask that you take some time to talk to your children about these and support them in becoming more familiar with the language used. During half term, Key Stage 2 will have a piece of homework that will be based upon this, which they will be given next week.

Well done again to those children who completed this year's Summer Reading Challenge. We were informed that our school had the second highest number of completers for the Summer Reading Challenge out of all Slough schools (24 completers). Well done to all those who took part.

Please remember that school will be closed next Wednesday 22nd, Thursday 23rd and Friday 24th October as we have three staff INSET days. There will be no newsletter next week so we take this opportunity to wish you all a good half term and staff will look forward to welcoming children on the 3rd November. Please remember that children are expected to be in winter school uniform, rather than Summer polo shirts and dresses, when we return after half term.

Congratulations to Kawthar Ma for progressing to Stage 2 in her swimming lessons. Well done Kawthar.



Calling all Altar Servers

Admission to Reception September 2026

The above admission round opened on the 15th of September 2025 and closes on 15th January 2026. You must apply via your local authority website completing a Common Application Form (CAF) for a place in a Reception class to start September 2026.

In addition to completing a CAF, please complete our Supplementary Form (Called 'Reception School Supplementary Form' on our website) and return with the relevant supporting documents to Holy Family Catholic School by 15th January 2026. Reception Supplementary Forms can be obtained from the school website or the school office.

Admission to 2 or 3-Year-Old Nurseries September 2026

The Nursery 2026 admission round is now open. Nursery application forms can be obtained from the school website or the school office; please complete our Application Form and return with the relevant supporting documents by 15th January 2026.

Eligibility for a Free School Meal – Information for Parents

Your child may be able to get free school meals if you receive any of the following:

Income Support

- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
