Dear Parents and Carers

This morning, Miss Iqbal's class led a beautiful class liturgy and shared their learning about the Presentation of the Lord and Candlemas. Children spoke and sang confidently; their timing was perfect and their messages uplifting. Children made the point every time we forgive or help someone our 'light' shines brighter and we live out our school mission statement making the world a better place. Well done to Year 3 and thank you to all our parents who made time to join us and celebrate with their children.

Our Year 2 children enjoyed a visit to Windsor Castle today, and represented our school beautifully. They had a good look around the grounds of the castle, and enjoyed looking closely at Queen Victoria's doll's house. Thank you to all parent volunteers who accompanied them.

On Wednesday, our Reception classes hosted a Stay & Play for parents, where children welcomed their parents or grandparents into their classrooms to give them an insight into their school day. It means so much to the children to have people they care about in school, and we are grateful that so many were able to attend. Thank you to Reception staff for organising and facilitating these events.

Our talented gymnasts went off-site on Thursday, representing our school at a Slough schools' competition. Mr Holder came back to school feeling so proud of you all; very well done to all the children who took part.

On Monday and Thursday of this week, children who are leading our 'Hearts on Fire, Feet on the Move' initiative stood up and presented their proposals for their clubs in front of Key Stage 1 and 2. They did a great job of speaking confidently in front of a sizeable audience, as well as sharing posters to show what their club is offering – these posters were then displayed in the dining hall, allowing the rest of the children to sign up to those they are interested in. It was delightful to listen to so many children talking about the Catholic Social Teaching principle of recognising the dignity of each person, as they described how welcoming they would be and how important it was to be inclusive to all who wished to attend. From Monday, we will have four weeks of organised chaos as we hand the reigns over to the children and they execute their plans; we currently have 31 new clubs running during break and lunchtimes!

After a week's pause in our building work, work will resume on Monday and is expected to continue until Easter. Weekly Sports Update


