Re: Ofsted Report Card

On our website you will find a copy of Holy Family Catholic Primary School Ofsted report from our inspection that took place on March 10th and 11th 2026.

At Holy Family Catholic Primary School, we are immensely proud of everything we provide for children including the success they achieve across the curriculum, the high standards children achieve across school and the enrichment experiences we offer.

The grade profile of the school is more 'strong standard' than 'expected standard'. In short, there is nothing that we should be doing that we are not doing. However, in each area judged expected, inspectors have highlighted an aspect of the school's work where they think we could do even better than we are already doing.

There has been a long delay in sharing the inspection report with you because as a school we evaluate all aspects of our school's provision to be 'strong standard', and we are disappointed that the inspection management and choice of inspection activities did not support the team of inspectors to find all of the evidence we know exists.

We are happy to celebrate with you a positive report showcasing many aspects of our school's provision that quite rightly deserve to be recognised. This is the fruit of many hours of hard work from both staff and children, and indicative of the dedication and support of our parents and families.

School staff are most proud that inspectors did record evidence to confirm:

Achievement: Across all key stages, pupils are consistently well prepared for the next stage of their education.

Attendance and behaviour: Warm, trusting relationships between staff and pupils contribute to a positive climate for learning.

Inclusion: Pupils feel valued and engage confidently in learning; well-planned opportunities help pupils build the knowledge, resilience and self-belief they need to achieve well.

Personal development and wellbeing: Pupils learn how to form positive relationships and friendships.

My favourite section is 'What it's like to be a pupil at this school'. This section isn't graded, however staff should feel immensely proud that they have created a school environment where 'pupils value the trusting relationships they have with staff and each other' and 'the school is an encouraging place, where pupils feel known as individuals'.

These comments are wonderful for our pupils, staff and families, and reflect the hard work and commitment of our whole school community in making Holy Family the special place it is. Thank you for your continued trust and partnership as we start this new academic year.

We will continue the excellent work that we are confident helps all of our pupils to thrive and flourish.
