At Holy Family Catholic Primary School, we are committed to providing a rich and meaningful Religious Education (RE) curriculum that nurtures the spiritual, moral, and academic development of every child.

To achieve this, we are currently teaching from the Religious Education Directory - To Know You More Clearly, in EYFS, Year 1and Year 6 as directed by The Diocese of Northampton and the Catholic Bishops' Conference of England and Wales. In Year 2, 3, 4 and 5 we are continuing to teach from the Come and See programme. We are following Diocesan phased implementation of fully teaching from the RED to achieve a comprehensive, scripture focused faith-filled approach to teaching RE.

We have set out below the strategic plan for the implementation of the new Religious Education Directory and associated curriculum at Holy Family Catholic School. CL
