Understanding the world and RE: Growing

Signs of Spring PowerPoint

Maths: Counting to 20

Practise counting your numbers to 20 out loud.

Challenge: can you count backwards too?!

Go on a number hunt around your house. What numbers can you find?

Understanding the World: Technology

If children have access to a computer programme such as paint ask them to paint a flower or spring picture. If not maybe they would like to draw or paint one!

Literacy/RE:

Learn the rhyme Hot Cross Buns.

Where else might you see a cross? Have a look at a hot cross bun or a picture of a hot cross bun.

Have a look at a picture of Jesus on the cross. The cross is a special symbol especially at Easter time. Easter is a time of new life, read a simple version of the Easter story explaining that Jesus dies on the cross but he came back to life to spread the good news.

Handwriting:

Can you write your name or the first letter of your name in your work books?

Post a picture of this onto your child's early essence account.

Understanding the World:

Spring – look at the Spring tick list in your pack. Look in your garden or out the window and see what you can see!
